Sedex Members Ethical Trade Audit

- Applicable to all product types
 - Audits conducted globally
 - Membership is required
 - Walmart requires completion of a 4-pillar audit

Fair Trade USA

- Applicable for agricultural operations including farming, packing & processing facilities
 - Audits conducted globally
 - Three-year certification cycle
 - Not a membership organization

Sustainability Initiative of South Africa

- Applicable to all agricultural products
 - Audits conducted in South Africa
 - Membership is a requirement

Best Aquaculture Practices / Best Seafood Practices

- Applicable to the aquaculture & wild seafood supply chain
 - Audits conducted globally
 - Certification scheme
 - Membership available, not required

Equitable Food Initiative

- Applicable for farming operations, including field, pack & processing facilities
 - Audits conducted in the Americas
 - Certification for three years
 - Not a membership organization

Ethical Supply Chain Program

- Applicable to all manufactured goods including toys, entertainment, juvenile, gifting, seasonal, and packaging products
 - Audits conducted globally
 - Certification scheme
 - Capability building training and support provided
 - Membership encouraged /not required

Total Quality. Assured. Small Supplier Program

Must meet definition of Small Supplier:

- The supplier's global sales revenue (total turnover) is under \$3 million per year; or
- The supplier's total global sales revenue to Flipkart Group Inc. is under \$350,000 per year

Supplier facilities located in a high-risk region/territory category will not be eligible to participate in the approved small supplier programs.

2 Complete a facility audit:

Provide an existing report that meets Flipkart Group's requirements:

- valid as defined by the Audit Program **OR** issued less than one year prior to the submit date (for programs without expiration dates)

Select an audit program from the list above and work with the program to conduct a facility audit with an approved firm.

To be accepted by Flipkart, the audit must be conducted:

- on a **semi-announced** (during a provided window of time) or **unannounced** basis (with no timeline or date provided)
- by an auditor **certified** by the Association of Professional Social Compliance Auditors (APSCA)
- on behalf of an APSCA member audit firm, approved and in good standing with both the program and with APSCA

- Further, if your facility's operations involve multiple shifts, the facility should be prepared to allow access to the auditor during **any shift** so that worker interviews and a factory tour can be conducted while the auditor is present.

3 Link Flipkart in the audit program platform

Each audit program has a unique platform for suppliers to grant retail partners access to audit details. Suppliers should link Flipkart Group to each factory for which an audit is submitted. Linking Flipkart Group allows our team to validate reports. Instructions on how to link Flipkart Group can be found in the audit program guide links in **Step 1**.

4 Submit your audit report via email

To be accepted, the email should include:

- Full audit report (and any additional documents specified in the program's resource guide)
- Flipkart Group Supplier ID number (8-digit number)
- Supplier Name
- Flipkart Group Factory ID Number
- Factory Name
- Audit Program Identification Number (ex. Sedex ID number)
- Audit Program Facility or Audit ID Number (helps Flipkart Group cross-reference the facility or audit)
