PAYING FOR YOUR BENEFITS

Your share of the cost for your benefits is normally taken out of your paycheck automatically. If you're away on leave, things work a bit differently.

- If you're on an approved short-term disability claim, the cost will be automatically deducted from your disability check or direct deposit in most states
- If you're on hourly short-term disability in California, Hawaii, New Jersey, New York, or Rhode Island, your disability payment won't be issued through Walmart, so you'll need to pay for your benefits yourself
- If you don't have an approved short-term disability claim, you'll need to cover your benefits payments yourself
